CALL FOR NOMINATION OF A MEMBER FOR THE COUNCIL ON HIGHER EDUCATION (CHE)

The Council on Higher Education is the statutory body established to provide independent, strategic advice to the Minister of Higher Education and Training on matters relating to the transformation and development of higher education in South Africa, and to manage quality assurance and quality promotion in the higher education sector.

Dr Bonginkosi Emmanuel Nzimande, MP, Minister of Higher Education and Training has by notice in Government Gazette No.35522 of 13 July 2012, invited nominations of persons who by virtue of his or her knowledge and experience, may be considered for appointment as a member of the aforesaid Council.

In terms of the Higher Education Act of 1997, the Minister must also invite nominations by notice in national newspapers. In this regard, the Minister hereby requests –

- a) the public;
- b) national organisations representing higher education students, academic employees, employees other than academic employees, university principals, technikon principals, principals of colleges of education, other higher education colleges, private higher education institutions, the further education sector, the distance education sector, educators, organised business, organised labour;
- c) research and science councils; and
- d) relevant non-governmental organisations

to submit before **7 August 2012** the names of persons who by virtue of his or her knowledge and experience, may be considered for appointment as a member of the aforesaid Council.

Nominations, accompanied by the *Curriculum Vitae* of the nominee and *a letter of consent indicating the availability of the nominee* to serve on the Council on Higher Education if selected, should be forwarded to:
