Fraud Alert

It has come to the attention of the Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET) that the *Centre for Fine Art Animation and Design* (CFAD) College has resurfaced and it is operating illegally in Cape Town after its licence was revoked late in 2016.

1. The reason for the cancellation of the registration of the institution is due to its:
2. Failure to Submit the Institution's Administrative Data;
3. Failure to Provide Staff and Student Data;
4. Failure to Submit Audited Annual Financial Statements;
5. Failure to Submit the Financial Surety;
6. Failure to Comply with the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations;
7. Failure to Provide Proof of Certificate Awarded to Students;
8. Failure to comply with the Requirements of the National Learner's Records Database (NLRD);
9. Failure to Provide the Updated Record of the Directors of the Company as Approved by the Consumer Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC);
10. Failure to Submit the List of Premises on which Teaching and Learning is provided; and
11. Failure to submit the Declaration Signed by Every Student.

According to the records of the Department, the **Centre for Fine Art Animation and Design (Pty) Ltd.'s** approved site of delivery was at 201 Salbany House, Albany Grove in Durban. The institution does not have a registered site in Cape Town.

Should it offer higher education programmes in Cape Town, it would be doing so illegally, and the Department will investigate the matter and act accordingly.
